NCP

- NCP = National Contact Point
- Intermediary between EC and the respective local constituency
- A network of local experts
- The NCP network is the main provider of advice and individual assistance in all Member States and Associated States.
- NCPs are appointed for each of the areas of FP7: ICT, NMP, Transport, ..., SME, legal & Finances, ...
- Trained by the EC
- Privileged position with the EC

NCP services

- Guidance on choosing thematic priorities and instruments
- Advice on administrative procedures and contractual issues
- Training on proposal writing
- Assistance on proposal writing
- Distribution of documentation (forms, guidelines, manuals etc.)
- Assistance in partner search (Partnering Event)
- Website (IWT: e-NCP)
- Feedback > EC (WP, ...)
