



Buzon first on the market to offer pedestals tested under ISO 17025 accreditation

For more than 30 years, the Liège-based family business [Buzon](#) has been developing and producing innovative adjustable pedestals for terraces for more than 30 years. This company attaches great importance to the quality of its product range, which it guarantees through regular testing.

The ergonomic and durable support systems consist of polymer that has been tested in the Sirris testlabs for more than 20 years. The tests realised by an independent laboratory, help Buzon obtain international quality certificates (CE, ICC, BBA ...) for their products.

The Sirris test laboratory in Seraing obtained a new ISO 17025 accreditation granted by Belac (Belgian Accreditation Body) for a compression test on the Buzon pedestals. This is a first. The necessary steps were taken by the end of 2020 (NB: via Teams!). This makes Buzon the first company to market these systems, which have been tested under ISO 17025 accreditation.
